Inspiration hits us in many forms, but none more powerful than through the trials we face when we find out we may have cancer.

Seven years ago, Selby Dunham was diagnosed with breast cancer and from day one she called herself a survivor.


Over the next year, she fought breast cancer and discovered that in her own community of Bighorn, she had countless friends whose encouragement made a difference in her recovery. She called on her fellow members to create Bighorn Behind A Miracle or BAM as it is affectionately called. Together, the team of Bighorn BAM created a golf tournament that would raise money to provide equipment and support for women throughout the Coachella Valley through Eisenhower Medical Center's Lucy Curci Cancer Center and The Pendleton Foundation. Inspiring sponsors, golfers, caddies and retailers, the industrious BAM women raised \$316,000 in its first year, over \$1 amillion in its fifth season and over \$2.56 million in the past five years!

Three years ago, after hearing the incredible story of Bighorn BAM, financial advisor and developer Fred Fern of The Shops on El Paseo decided they also wanted to support breast cancer survivors. Together the groups collaborated and created A Miracle on El Paseo to celebrate the launch of the holiday season. A Miracle on El Paseo is the street's biggest and only block party. Referred to as the "Rockefeller Lighting Ceremony of the Desert, " the annual gala closes one block of El Paseo to street traffic creating a Winter Wonderland complete with the season's first snowfall, live music and an ice rink with skating by Olympic caliber skaters. This year's theme is "Fire& Ice", with tastes and libations from the valley's top restaurants, special activities and a donation of percentages of sales at the many luxury boutiques found at The Shops on El Paseo.

The grand finale includes the arrival of Santa Claus and the magical illumination of the street's 60-foot Christmas tree by Olympic figure skating champion and breast cancer survivor Dorothy Hamill.

Hamill, Winner of the 1976 Gold Medal in Women's Figure Skating, the 1976 World Championship and three U.S. titles, has lent her support in the fight against breast cancer in the Coachella Valley as the honorary chairperson for this year's Miracle on El Paseo.
